Books n' Books: 2021 State Aid Funds

Utilizing funds provided by the Oklahoma Department of Libraries, the Library has purchased 43+ new titles 62+ replacement and duplicate titles for the Youth Fiction Department, some of which will replace lost or stolen items while others are duplicates of beloved titles, including past Newbery and Sequoyah winners, and series such as Dog Man and Diary of a Wimpy Kid that are in a state of disrepair. Similarly, the Library has added 25 new and replacement Adult fiction titles, 34 new films, and 15 replacements for lost or stolen films. Currently the Library has utilized \$2,412.08 of \$3,758 of state aid funding. Some items to consider for the remaining funds includes new board and



card games for patron use, a wide-mouth lamination machine, and other resources and materials as requested by the public.

Summer Reading registration kicked off June 1st - participants can register at any time during the summer. The Program begins June 7th with Quick-Frozen Critters - a tag-based game meant to teach participants the difference between prey and predator, as well as concepts such as herbivorous, omnivorous, and carnivorous animals.
